BOIL ORDER NOTIFICATION POLICY

- I. Causes of Boil Water Notices
 - A. Precautionary Boil Water Notice – issued by the North Garland County Regional Water District when a presumption is made that the water may be contaminated and the notice is for precautionary reasons.
 - B. Contaminated Boil Water Notice – issued by the North Garland County Regional Water District when the presumption is made that the water is contaminated based on supporting evidence.
- II. Notification Procedures
 - A. Number of Services Affected – 1 to 25
Personal notification shall be made to each customer by means of telephone notification. If the customer cannot be reached by telephone, then a door hanger shall be left on the premises of the customer explaining the purpose of the notification.
 - B. Number of Services Affected – 26 to 99
Notification will be made by posting a written notice in frequented places such as post offices, convenience stores, churches or community centers. A notice may be distributed through the news media.
 - C. Number of Services Affected – 99 or more
A notice will be distributed through the news media and additional notification will be made by posting a written notice in frequented places such as post offices, convenience stores, churches or community centers.
