**SEVERE WEATHER POLICY**

When severe weather such as ice storms, snow storms, tornado activity or any other known forecasted event has been forecast or predicted in our local area that would threaten the constant supply of electric power to our water treatment plant and pumping station the following policy shall be implemented immediately:


The employees of the North Garland County Regional Water District shall make every effort to ensure that dead-end water mains are flushed clear and all water tanks have been flushed and filled to maximum levels.

Tanks shall be kept at maximum levels until such time as the potential crisis is over or nonexistent or until it is no longer possible to maintain electric power to the water treatment plant from our normal source, in which case alternate power supplies shall be obtained.

Adopted this 27<sup>th</sup>, day of June 2017 by the Board of Directors.
